E-RESOURCES

Students at D.B.M.S. College of Education have access to a wide variety of books and journals for reference; however, they favour using those that are based on their course syllabus. There are 6300 books here. We have DELNET, INFLIBNET, and E-SHODHSINDHU subscriptions, which give teachers and students access to a large library of literature.

A DELNET subscription has been acquired by D.B.M.S. College of Education to provide remote access to library resources. In the wake of the pandemic, we have contemplated utilizing DELNET to assess books from remote regions, which will benefit educators and students alike. By establishing a network of libraries, DELNET's primary objective was to promote resource sharing across libraries. Its goals include collecting, storing, and sharing information; coordinating efforts for suitable collection development; and, whenever possible, reducing unnecessary duplication in addition to offering clients computerized services.



The "National Library and Information Services Infrastructure for Scholarly Content (N-LIST)" project, which is being carried out in collaboration between the INDEST-AICTE Consortium at IIT Delhi and the e-ShodhSindhu Consortium at INFLIBNET Centre, enables i) cross-subscription to e-resources that are subscribed by the two Consortiums, i.e., e-ShodhSindhu resources for technical institutions and INDEST-AICTE resources for universities; and ii) access to specific e-resources for colleges. Through server(s) installed at the INFLIBNET Centre, the N-LIST project gives instructors, researchers, and students from universities and other beneficiary institutions access to e-resources. After being properly verified as allowed users via servers set up at the INFLIBNET Centre, authorized users from universities can now access e-resources and download the articles they need straight from the publisher's website.

Additionally, the INFLIBNET Centre is in charge of creating and implementing suitable software tools and methods for approved user authentication.

The Ministry of HRD (now known as the Ministry of Education) created e-ShodhSindhu by combining three consortium initiatives—the INDEST-AICTE Consortium, NLIST, and the UGC-INFONET Digital Library Consortium—on the advice of an Expert Committee. The e-ShodhSindhu will continue to offer its member institutions, which include centrally funded technical institutions, universities, and colleges covered by 12(B) and 2(f) Sections of the UGC Act, both current and archival access to over 10,000 core and peer-reviewed journals as well as a number of bibliographic, citation, and factual databases in various disciplines from numerous publishers and aggregators.

The primary goal of e-Shodh Sindhu: Consortia for Higher Education E-Resources is to give academic institutions cheaper subscription prices for high-quality electronic resources, including as full-text, bibliographic, and factual databases. The following are the main goals and objectives of the e-Shodh Sindhu:

establishing e-Shodh Sindhu: Consortia for Higher Education E-Resources by enhancing and fortifying the services and initiatives provided by three consortia financed by the MHRD; Create an impressive library of e-books, e-journal archives, and e-journals with permanent access; Through awareness and training initiatives, track and encourage the use of e-resources in participating Indian universities, colleges, and technical institutions;

- All educational institutions should have access to subscription-based academic materials, such as e-books and e-journals;
- Make scholarly content accessible through subject portals and subject gateways that are open access;
- close the digital divide and create a society that is rich in information;
- Give other institutions, such as open universities and MHRD-funded institutions not included in current consortia, access to specific e-resources;
- Engage in extra services and activities that call for a collaborative platform and aren't being carried out by current consortiums; and
- Advancing the creation of a National Electronic Library, with electronic books and journals serving as its main constituents.

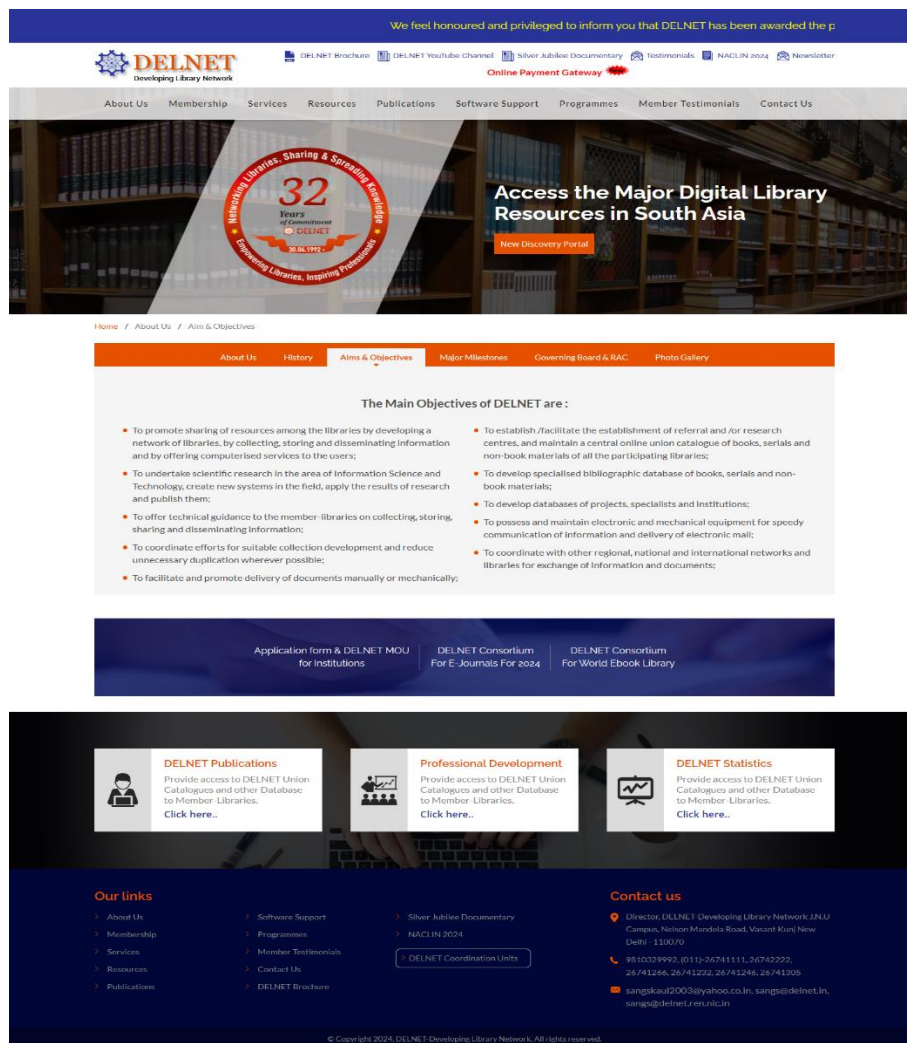


FIG 5: DELNET USERS LOGIN DASHBOARD

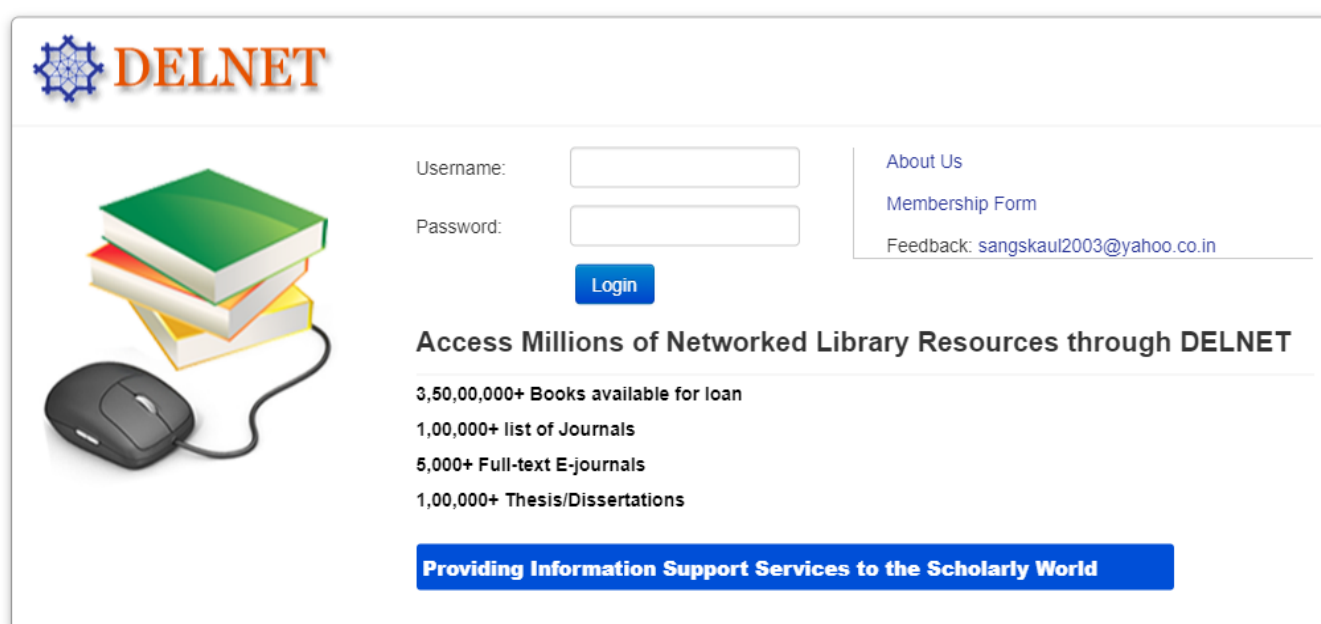


FIG 6: NATIONAL LIBRARY AND INFORMATION SERVICES INFRASTRUCTURE FOR SCHOLARLY CONTENT (N-LIST) DASHBOARD

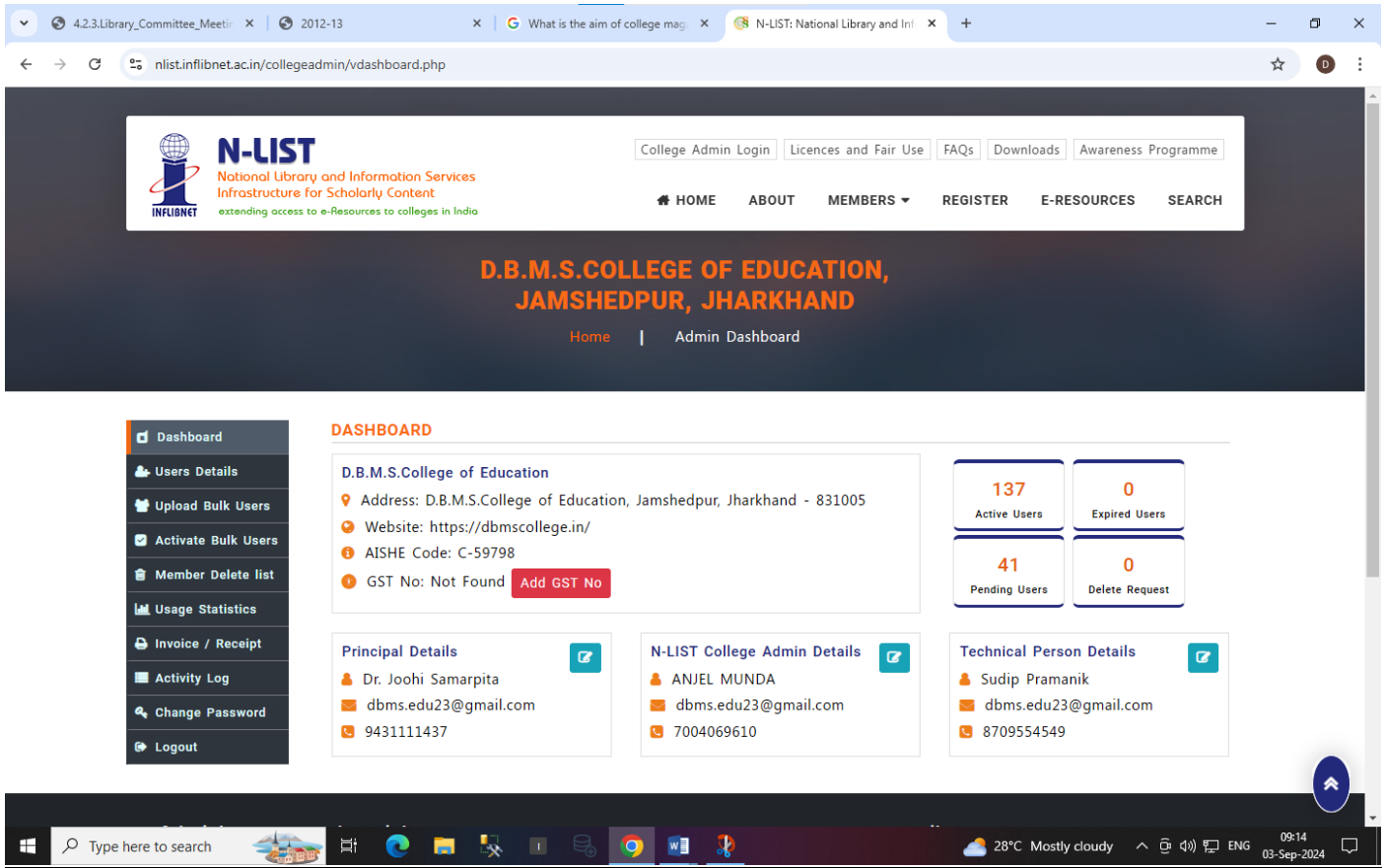


FIG 7: N-LIST MEMBERS RECORD DASHBOARD

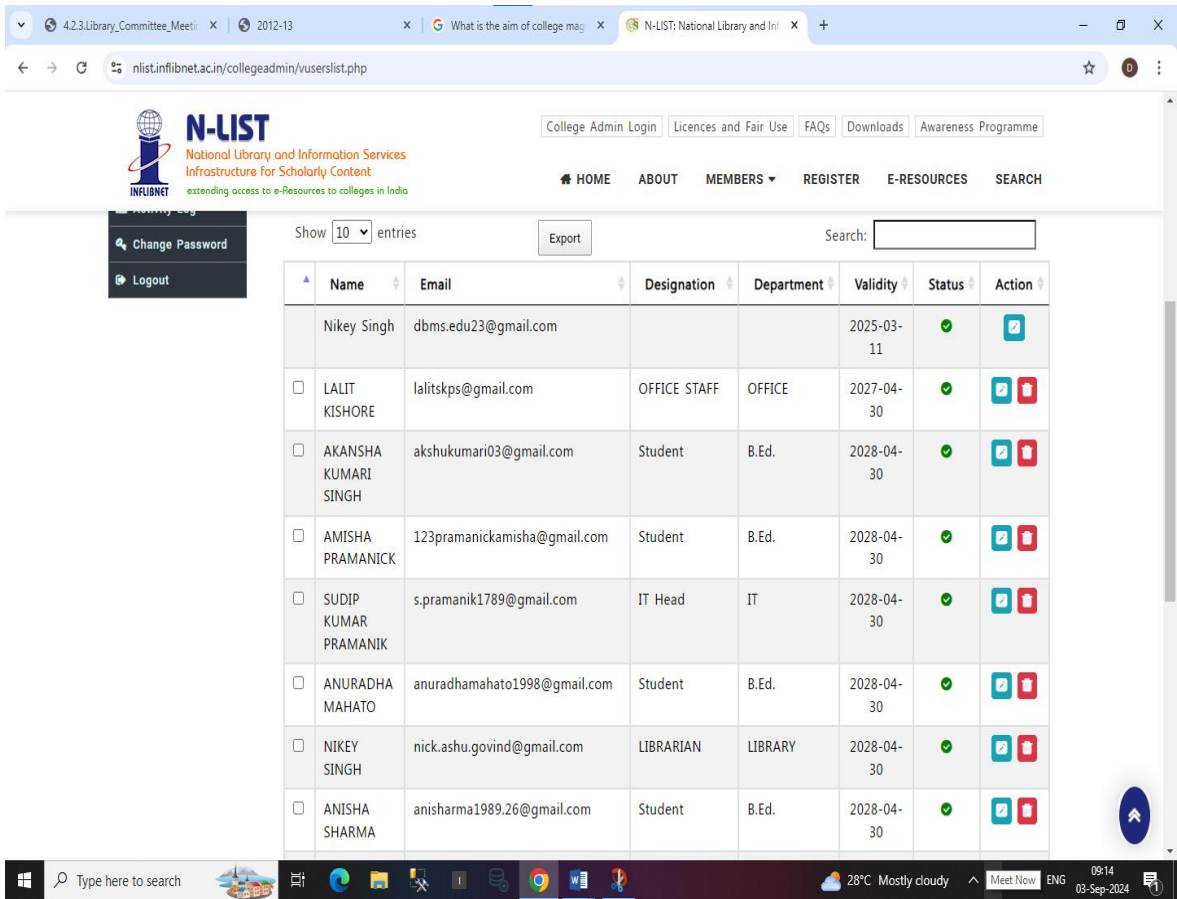


FIG 8: USER DETAIL DASHBOARD
